### **Historical Markers Dedication Event for National Register Sites in the City of Anoka**

**ANOKA, Minn.** – In late 2014, the City of Anoka Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC) was graciously awarded a \$10,000 grant from the State of Minnesota from the Arts and Cultural Heritage Fund through the Minnesota Historical Society to create and install interpretive historical markers at each of the nine National Register of Historic Places sites in Anoka. The National Register sites include:

- Anoka Post Office (300 E Main St.)
- Anoka-Champlin Mississippi River Bridge
- Colonial Hall (1900 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave.) and Masonic Lodge #30 (1908 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave.)
- Jackson Hotel (214 Jackson St.)
- Kline Sanitarium (1500 S. Ferry Rd.)
- Shaw-Hammons House (302 Fremont St.)
- Ticknor House (1625 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave.)
- Windego Park Auditorium (1830 Ferry St.)
- Woodbury House (1632 Ferry St.)

The HPC will be holding a historical markers dedication event on **July 22, 2016 at 3:00 p.m. at the Woodbury House (1632 Ferry St.)** to celebrate the completion of the project and to recognize the historical marker recipients and project stakeholders. From 3:30 – 4:30 p.m. there will be a self-guided walking tour of each of the nine National Register sites starting at the Woodbury House. From 4:30 – 5:30 p.m. there will be a social hour at the Jackson Hotel (Billy's – 214 Jackson St.) which is one of the National Register properties being recognized. The public is welcomed and encouraged to attend.
