



PLANNING COMMISSION

Powers & Duties

- The Planning Commission is a volunteer board of Anoka residents charged with studying and recommending to the City Council ways in which to carry out the Zoning Code and related regulations.
- In this capacity, the Commission has the responsibility to maintain and update the Anoka Community Plan (comprehensive plan); to conduct public hearings and make recommendations to the City Council on zoning classifications, rezonings, plats, variances, conditional use permits, and development site plans.
- The Commission receives citizen input, solicits all available information on an issue and recommends appropriate action to the City Council for final action.
- The Commission consists of seven members appointed by the Mayor and City Council. Planning Commission meetings are regularly held in the City Council Chambers on the first Tuesday of the month, at 7:00 p.m. Quad Cities Television (QCTV) broadcasts these meetings live.
