WATERFOWL FOR WARRIORS IS SIMPLE.

It's a way to say thank you to our Nation's heroes by providing them with an opportunity to enjoy the outdoors.

WHERE: Anoka Nature Preserve:
Located along the beautiful Rum River to the northwest of Bunker Lake Blvd. and 7th Ave. NW, in the City of Anoka.

WHEN: *September 3 and 15 for early goose season and October 9 and 20* for regular waterfowl season. Hunting will take place from one 1/2 hour before sunrise to 12 p.m. (noon).*

WHO: *Veterans will be the hunters. Volunteers will provide everything needed to create the memories of a quality hunt.*

HOW MORNING HUNTS UNFOLD:

- *Hunters will meet volunteers on the morning of the hunt in the Anoka Nature Preserve parking lot. Waivers of Claim will be signed at this time.*
- *Hunters will then be transported to the field where blinds and decoys will be set up for the hunt.*
- *Volunteers will be calling birds and providing dogs for retrieving, as well as patrolling the perimeter of the field ensuring a safe hunt.*
- *12ga ammunition will be provided for the hunt—thanks to our good friends at Federal Premium Ammunition in Anoka.*
- *Immediately following the hunt, hunters and volunteers will enjoy photo opportunities in the field.*
- *Lunch will be provided to end the day.*

LICENSING INFORMATION/REQUIREMENTS FROM THE MINNESOTA DNR:

All hunters are required to obtain the appropriate hunting licenses from the State of MN to hunt waterfowl. Federal Migratory Bird Stamp (Duck Stamp) is required. MN Early Goose license may apply for September hunting dates. Please contact the MN DNR for licensing requirements and information at: 651-296-6157

A MN resident serving in the U.S. Military and stationed outside the state may hunt small game without a license while on leave. No MN Waterfowl Stamp is needed but must have a Federal Migratory Bird Stamp to hunt waterfowl.

Resident Veterans: *With proof of a 100 percent service-related disability may obtain a free Small Game License (241). In addition, a disabled veteran is exempt from purchasing state pheasant or waterfowl stamps, but must purchase a federal duck stamp to hunt waterfowl.*

100% Disabled Resident Veteran Permanent Card: *Resident veterans who have 100 percent permanent service-connected disability as defined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs may apply for a permanent card that may be presented to an agent annually to receive a free Small Game and/or a Deer License. This card will assist with the process of receiving these types of licenses, however all eligibility requirements must be met prior to receiving the license(s). Application available at:*
